



“Critical Thinking Exercise”

After covering a specific lesson, I have students form into groups of three to four members. The teams are presented a critical thinking problem regarding the specific topic. Each group is provided with the same problem statement. Each group will work together as a team solving the problem. Resources include but are not limited to the Internet, textbook, and LRC. Each team will provide a brief presentation of the solution to the class in the next class meeting. Each member must be part of the discussion during the presentation. This critical thinking exercise promotes higher level critical thinking, teamwork philosophy, research methodology, and improvements to communication and presentation skills. Due to time constraints, this is often done only once a quarter
